

District Happenings

Hello Everyone,

Attached are two resolutions I've written. I will be presenting both to my next post meeting which I hope will be forward to the district for consideration.

The first requires districts to offer remote meeting options (conference call and online platforms) for all district meetings. The rationale is:

- 1. The Department is still operating as it did over 100 years ago by requiring in person meetings.
- 2. Some districts encompass up to 8 counties requiring members to travel long distances to attend meetings.
- 3. Requires an aging membership to travel often at night and during inclement weather
- 4. Districts all have the capability to offer conference calling or online meetings.
- 5. Will allow the Department to function during a national emergency or pandemic.

The second requires posts to attend at least 80% of district meetings or face possible sanctions. The rationale is:

- 1. Districts cannot function without a post quorum.
- 2. Department incentives alone have not worked to increase post participation.
- 3. Post members and veterans are hurt by posts not participating in district meetings.
